Broad Support

ARIZONA RATE ADJUSTMENT

Southwest Gas recently received approval of a base rate adjustment, the first in five years.

Customer Protection

- The Company's decoupling mechanism is being renamed the Delivery Charge Adjustment Provision (DCA) and is simplified to have one annual adjustment that financially protects both customers and the company by ensuring the Company only recovers the delivery charges approved by the Commission – no more; no less.
- The Company will not file another rate case prior to May 1, 2019.
