As-built Request, Redline and Civil Improvement Plan Signature:

Southwest Gas provides as-built drawings to engineering firms to properly identify natural gas facilities on design plans for construction projects. Southwest Gas also reviews all proposed design plans for conflicts throughout the civil design process to prepare for final utility signatures.

- To obtain as-builts and begin the redline process for a design project, please submit your request to the Southwest Gas Southern Nevada Division Engineering Department through our file transfer site.
- To submit plans for review, please upload a transmittal indicating the project name, PDF of full plan set, and a completed Plan Review Checklist at file transfer site

Final mylar approval will be conducted electronically due to COVID-19. To submit final mylar plans for approval please upload a transmittal indicating project name, PDF of full plan set, and a completed Plan Review Checklist to our file transfer site.

The PDF copy of the full plan set and a Southwest Gas final approved transmittal will be returned to the customer. The printed Southwest Gas final approved transmittal must accompany the mylar set to the governing municipality for their approval. Complete adherence to the final transmittal instructions is required for final submittal to municipalities.

Vacation Request:

Southwest Gas reviews Vacation Requests from the various governmental agencies within the Southern Nevada Service Territory. To submit a Vacation Request please complete the Application for Vacation Request form and email to the Southwest Gas Southern Nevada Division Engineering Department at snv-engineering@swgas.com.

Final Maps and Amended Final Maps:

Southwest Gas reviews Final Maps and Amended Final Maps to properly identify that the owner's dedication within Final Maps and relinquished areas within Amended Final Maps are not in conflict with natural gas facilities or Southwest Gas' ability to provide natural gas to our customers. To submit a Final Map or Amended Final Map, please complete the Application for Final Map/Amended Final Map and email to the Southwest Gas Southern Nevada Division Engineering Department at snv-engineering@swgas.com. Final Maps and Amended Final Maps will be quarantined for 3 days prior to review to mitigate the spread of COVID-19.
