Southwest Gas Corporation Files Application with Public Utilities Commission of Nevada Seeking Approval to Expand Natural Gas Infrastructure (Notice to Mesquite Expansion Area Customers)

Southwest Gas Corporation filed an Application with the Public Utilities Commission of Nevada November 3, 2017 seeking approval to expand natural gas infrastructure to serve Mesquite, Nevada pursuant to Senate Bill 151 and the Regulations approved in Docket No. 15-05025. The total estimated increase in the Company's revenues from anticipated Mesquite Expansion Area customers in Year 1 of available gas service is \$839,358 or 0.3%. ⁽¹⁾

The table below shows the estimated average monthly bill for each rate schedule. The impact to individual customer bills will vary depending on the amount of gas consumed.
