Install gaslights on the wall or close to the ground to illuminate a sidewalk or path. You can even choose luau or tiki torches to add a touch of island flair to your outdoor room. Not only do gaslights improve your home security instantly, they are well suited for areas near the pool, spa and outdoor cooking areas.

During power outages, you can be sure the reliable glow of your natural gaslights will not be interrupted.

Maintenance tips:

- Keep sprinkler systems from spraying gaslight heads. Tap water and the minerals it contains cause a mineral deposit which is very hard to clean. Spray systems can also spray into the bottoms of the gaslight heads causing the mantles to break, valves to freeze up and internal rusting of the post.
- Putting a small flowerbed or rock garden around the base of the post will protect the post from weed eaters and lawn mowers bumping into the post and causing the paint to chip and rust as well as breaking the mantles by shaking the lamp. Vibrations are the leading cause of premature mantle failure!

- Tiki (open flame)
- One, two and three mantles
