Base Tariff Energy Rate Change — Southern Nevada Division

On September 28, 2007, Southwest Gas Corporation (Southwest) filed its quarterly Base Tariff 2007, natural gas rates for Southwest's Southern Nevada customers will increase by \$0.01027 per therm, which represents an approximate 1.2 percent increase in the gas cost portion of rates. A single-family residential customer's average monthly bill will increase \$0.43. The total increase is Energy Rate (BTER) with the Public Utilities Commission of Nevada. Effective November 1, approximately \$3.9 million for all customer classes.
