The purpose of this filing is to adjust Southwest's Southern and Northern Nevada Base Tariff Energy Rates. These rates will become effective October 1, 2010.

The table on the back of this notice shows the changes for the average monthly bill for each customer class. The change to individual customer bills will vary depending on the amount of gas consumed.



The annualized change in revenues is a decrease of \$1,524,036 or 1.23%. Effective October 1, 2010, natural gas rates for Southwest's Northern Nevada customers will decrease by \$0.01582 per therm.
