Southwest Gas Corporation (Southwest) (U 905 G) tenders herewith for filing the following tariff sheets.

The purpose of this filing is to amend the Facilities Surcharge Rate contained in Preliminary Statement 16 of Southwest's California Gas Tariff. The Facilities Surcharge Rate was unintentionally revised in Advice Letter (AL) 864. AL 864, effective April 24, 2011, was filed in order to renumber Southwest's California Gas Tariff pursuant to the numbering system set forth in General Rule 8.4.2. In addition to the new tariff numbering system, other revisions to the tariff were made, including revisions for text uniformity, incorrect references, and updating maps, customer forms, and definitions. It was recently discovered that there was a typographical error in the Facilities Surcharge Rate shown on Sheet No. 26 and it was inadvertently changed from \$.12418 to \$.12416 in AL 864. However, Southwest's customers were never charged the rate of \$.12416, and have been correctly



charged the rate of \$.12418.

Pursuant to discussion with Energy Division Staff, due to the length of time that has passed from the disposition of AL 864, Southwest was not able to correct this error through a substitute sheet filing. However, since this revision is ministerial in nature and customers have not been charged an incorrect rate, Southwest believes this Advice Letter is subject to Energy Division disposition and should be classified as Tier 1 (effective pending disposition) pursuant to General Order (GO) 96-B. therefore, respectfully requests that this advice letter become effective on February 23, 2012, which is the date filed.

16. FACILITIES SURCHARGE

16A. PURPOSE

The purpose of this provision is to provide for the collection of a Facilities Surcharge per therm of gas usage in the Company's Northern California Expansion Areas as approved in Decision Nos. 94-12-022 and 00-02-016.

16B. APPLICABILITY

The Facilities Surcharge applies to all natural gas volumes delivered in the Company's Northern California Expansion Areas in Placer, El Dorado and Nevada Counties, as delineated in the "Description of Expansion Service Area" of this California Gas Tariff.

16C. TERM

The Facilities Surcharge shall not change and shall remain in effect until the approved recovery amount, including interest accrued monthly on the unrecovered balance at an annual rate of 8.2 percent, is fully amortized.

16D. RATE

The Facilities Surcharge, including an amount necessary to recover currently-authorized franchise fees and uncollectible accounts expense, is equal to \$.12418 per therm.

The Facilities Surcharge will be multiplied by the applicable volumes to determine the total surcharge amount.

16E. SPECIAL CONDITIONS

- 1. Pursuant to Decision Nos. 94-12-022 and 00-02-016, Northern California Expansion Area construction costs in excess of the estimated project costs, but within the approved cost cap, will be added to the amount to be recovered through the Facilities Surcharge.
- 2. The total Facilities Surcharge amount will be shown as a separate line item on the customer's monthly bill.
